

Ray served on the GCU Board of Trustees from 2003-2015 and served in a leadership capacity as Chair of the Board from 2011-2015 and Vice Chair from 2006-2011. Rav was deeply involved in the key decisions for the creation of our nursing program in 2008 and Georgian Court to become a co-ed university in 2013. Ray also chaired the GCU Gala in 2004 & 2005 and was an active supporter of the Annual Scholarship and Golf Outing. Ray contributed both

his time and resources to Georgian Court University including a transformational gift to benefit the creation of the Wellness Center. In 2021, the university's Board of Trustees unanimously voted to create the Raymond F. Shea Jr. Memorial Scholarship in his memory. The scholarship will be given to a full-time undergraduate student with a minimum GPA of 3.0 and with proven financial need.

Ray's legacy will live on in perpetuity through his years of noble service and the many students who will carry on his good work in his honor.
